

Torpedo Instructions

Sew shoulder seams and finish them in some neat & tidy manner of your choice. Turn to the outside (right side) and baste in place a scant ¼ inch seam allowance around the entire neck and coat fronts. Sew the ribbon to the coat front/neckline, covering the turned-over raw edge. (Alternatively, you can narrow hem the fronts & neckline edges, and then apply the ribbon.)

Sew the ribbon onto the pocket as shown in the photo, and then turn under and baste the seam allowances to create the finished pockets. Sew them in place on the coat fronts, allowing space for the side seams and hem of the coat.

Hem the sleeves, and sew the ribbon onto the sleeves as shown in the photo. Pin the sleeves into the armseye and stitch them in. Sew the underarm and side seams of the coat, and finish the seams, if desired.

Hem the coat.
